

The 12-week C1 Course

Course overview

This intensive C1 course gives you everything you need to pass your C1 in just three months, in a flexible course that fits your busy schedule. Over twelve weeks you'll have three hours of live class per week: one session focusing on learning and using C1 English in a communicative and dynamic way, and another hour where you'll explore the C1 exam in detail, along with effective exam strategies to help you achieve the success you deserve. You'll also have regular assessed exam tasks, interactive group tasks on our online community, and 1-to-1 coaching sessions to help you reach your goals in your way. In total, that's more than 70 hours of guided study time in just 12 weeks - a perfect way to help you get the C1 you deserve quickly.

Course structure & provisional timetable

- 1. Live sessions** will be held on Zoom each week. Each 2-hour session uses the course material as its basis, with a clear focus on communicative use of English. As well as exploring and practicing a wide variety of language, each session also includes formal speaking exam practice and feedback, making sure you're able to excel in this part of the test.
- 2. Exam Expert sessions** will be held on Zoom each week. Each one-hour session will explore at least two parts of the exam in detail, helping you understand what you have to do and the best strategies to do it, and give you a chance to practice each part of the exam in class.
- 3. The course Slack** is an online community we will be using throughout the course. As well as our main channel for sharing information together, you will use Slack for weekly interactive tasks with your fellow course participants and regular group work on various aspects of the exam. *Slack* also gives you access to the course Google Drive, containing an extensive library of additional material, practice, and reference guides.
- 4. Assignments and private study.** You will be expected to complete some short tasks in preparation for each of the live sessions, and will additionally be set one writing task during each week of the course. You should expect to spend around 1 hour completing the assignment, and at least another 1-2 hours per week on self-study and exam practice.
- 5. Mock exams & tutorials.** Mock exams are an invaluable way of checking your progress towards your C1 goal. You will be given the opportunity to complete 4 mock exams during the course. You can also sign up for 1-to-1 tutorials with your teacher to discuss your progress and set learning targets.
